## A BILL ENTITLED

1	AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Supplementary
2	Appropriations – Public Works – Snow Removal
3	
4	FOR the purpose of making supplementary appropriations from unanticipated revenues to the
5	Department of Public Works in the general fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016;
6	and making this Ordinance an emergency measure.

8	BY amending: Current Expense Budget
9	
10	WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the
11	County Executive, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations from
12	revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget or from revenues
13	received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates for the current
14	fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such funds are
15	available for appropriation; and
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17	WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended supplementary appropriations,
18	and the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for
19	appropriation; now, therefore,

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SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, be and it is hereby amended by making supplementary appropriations from revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates as follows:

Unappropriated Fund Balance - General Fund

\$ 5,000,000

and by adding such appropriation of funds to the below-listed department in the respective

Department of Public Works – General Fund Appropriation

800,000 Contractual Services \$ 2,700,000 Supplies & Materials \$1,500,000

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date that it becomes law.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace. health, safety, welfare, and property, and being passed by the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law.
