16	SECTION1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,

18-2-109. Comprehensive Zoning; Notices and signs.

(A) **Definition.** FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "APPLICANT" MEANS THE PROPERTY OWNER OF RECORD OR AN AGENT OF THE PROPERTY OWNER OF RECORD.

(A) Notice. (B) Notice and signs. AN APPLICANT REQUESTING RECEIVING A CHANGE OF ZONING BY AMENDMENT TO A COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BILL FOR A ZONING CHANGE NOT REQUESTED BY APPLICATION TO NOT PREVIOUSLY REVIEWED BY THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND ZONING SHALL, WITHIN FIVE DAYS OF THE PASSAGE OF THE ZONING CHANGE AMENDMENT, COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS.

(1) THE APPLICANT SHALL SEND A NOTICE CONTAINING INFORMATION ABOUT THE AMENDMENT REQUEST, BY FIRST CLASS MAIL POSTAGE PREPAID, TO EACH PERSON OWNING LAND LOCATED WITHIN 175 FEET OF THE OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY, AS WELL AS TO ANY COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION FOR A COMMUNITY LOCATED WITHIN 175 FEET OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY. THE NOTICE SHALL INCLUDE A STATEMENT INDICATING THAT A COPY OF THE APPLICATION FILED WITH THE COUNTY COUNCIL AMENDMENT AND EXHIBIT ADDING THE ZONING CHANGE TO THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BILL MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE APPLICANT OR THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL. THE APPLICANT SHALL SUBMIT AN AFFIDAVIT OF MAILING SIGNED BY ALL PROPERTY OWNERS OF RECORD, ALONG WITH A COPY OF EACH LETTER, WITH THEIR APPLICATION FOR A ZONING AMENDMENT TO THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL.

(2) THE APPLICANT SHALL POST A SIGN ON THE SUBJECT PROPERTY GIVING NOTICE OF THE AMENDMENT, IN THE MANNER PROVIDED IN SECTION 18-16-203(D)(2) OF THIS CODE. THE SIGN SHALL REMAIN POSTED ON THE SUBJECT PROPERTY FOR NOT LESS THAN 14 DAYS. THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND ZONING SHALL FURNISH THE SIGNS TO THE APPLICANT AND THE APPLICANT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR POSTING AND MAINTAINING THE SIGNS.

(B) Signs.

(1) FOR A PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN 14 DAYS BEFORE THE DATE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING AT WHICH A PROPOSED AMENDMENT FOR A ZONING CHANGE NOT REQUESTED BY APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND ZONING MAY BE ADDED TO A COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BILL, ONE OR MORE SIGNS SHALL BE POSTED ON THE SUBJECT PROPERTY IN THE MANNER PROVIDED IN SECTION 18-16-203(D) OF THIS CODE.

(2) AN APPLICANT FOR A CHANGE IN ZONING BY AMENDMENT FOR A ZONING CHANGE NOT REQUESTED BY APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND ZONING SHALL FILE AN AFFIDAVIT SIGNED BY ALL PROPERTY OWNERS OF RECORD WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL INDICATING THAT THE PROPERTY OWNER OF RECORD HAS COMPLIED WITH THE POSTING REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION PRIOR TO THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BILL AT WHICH THE AMENDMENT MAY BE CONSIDERED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL.

(C) Not a Limitation. THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO RESTRICT OR LIMIT THE LEGISLATIVE POWER OF A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL TO AMEND A COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BILL, WITH OR WITHOUT NOTICE.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
