1	AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Transfer of Appropriation – Contingency
2	Account – Fire Department – Grants, Contributions & Other
3	
4	FOR the purpose of transferring an appropriation of funds from the Contingency Account of
5	the Chief Administrative Officer to the Fire Department; making this Ordinance an
6	emergency measure; and generally relating to transferring appropriations of funds in the
7	current expense budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015.

9	BY amending: Current Expense Budget
10	
11	WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, the County Executive may
12	authorize transfers of funds within the same department and within the same fund;
13	and

15	WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, upon recommendation of the
16	County Executive, the County Council may transfer funds between offices,
17	departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies of the County
18	government and within the same fund of the Current Expense Budget; and

20	WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the transfer of certain funds
21	and the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for
22	appropriation; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, 1 That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, be and it is hereby 2 amended by transferring the appropriation of funds from the below-listed department in the 3 amount set forth: 4 5 Chief Administrative Office - General Fund Appropriation 6 7 Contingency \$331,000 Grants, Contributions & Other 8 9 and by transferring such appropriation of funds to the below-listed department in the 10 respective amount set forth: 11 12 Fire Department - General Fund Appropriation 13 Planning & Logistics 14 \$ 331,000 Grants, Contributions & Other 15 16 SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an 17 emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, 18 health, safety, welfare, and property and being passed by the affirmative vote of five 19 members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law. 20 21 SECTION 2.
