A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Transfer of Funds
2 and Additional Appropriation
3

4 FOR the purpose of transferring an appropriation of funds from the Contingency Account of
5 the Chief Administrative Officer to the Office of Sheriff and the Circuit Court; making
6 an additional appropriation of unanticipated revenues to the Grants Special Revenue
7 Fund for the current fiscal year; making this Ordinance an emergency measure; and
8 generally relating to transferring appropriations of funds and additional appropriations of
9 funds to the current expense budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014.

11 BY amending: Current Expense Budget

13 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, the County Executive may
14 authorize transfers of funds within the same department and within the same fund;

17 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, upon recommendation of the
18 County Executive, the County Council may transfer funds between offices,
19 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies of the County
20 government and within the same fund of the Current Expense Budget; and

22 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the
23 County Executive, the County Council may make additional appropriations from

1 revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates and
 2 from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget for the current
 3 fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such funds
 4 are available for appropriation; and

 6 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the transfer of certain funds
 7 and additional appropriations and the Controller has certified in writing that such
 8 funds are available for appropriation; now, therefore,

 10 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
 11 That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, be and it is hereby
 12 amended by transferring the appropriation of funds from the below-listed department




