1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Public Safety – Speed Monitoring Systems

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the use of speed monitoring systems in the County; and
4 generally relating to public safety.

6 BY adding: § 12-3-109
7 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

9 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
10 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

ARTICLE 12. PUBLIC SAFETY

TITLE 3. TRAFFIC

12-3-109. Speed monitoring systems.

18 (A) **Definition.** AS USED IN THIS SECTION, “SPEED MONITORING SYSTEM” HAS THE
19 MEANING SET FORTH IN § 21-809 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE OF THE STATE CODE.

21 (B) **Use authorized.** THE USE OF SPEED MONITORING SYSTEMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH
22 § 21-809 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE OF THE STATE CODE IS AUTHORIZED IN ANNE
23 ARUNDEL COUNTY.

25 (C) **Citation prohibition.** IF THE COUNTY MOVES OR PLACES A MOBILE OR
26 STATIONARY SPEED MONITORING SYSTEM TO OR AT A LOCATION WHERE A SPEED


1 MONITORING SYSTEM HAD NOT PREVIOUSLY BEEN MOVED OR PLACED, A CITATION MAY
2 NOT BE ISSUED FOR A VIOLATION RECORDED BY THE SPEED MONITORING SYSTEM UNTIL
3 AT LEAST 15 CALENDAR DAYS AFTER THE INSTALLATION OF SIGNAGE IN ACCORDANCE
4 WITH § 21-809 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE OF THE STATE CODE.

6 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
7 from the date it becomes law.


