1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Positions in the Exempt Service – Police
2 Department

4 FOR the purpose of ~~increasing certain exempt positions in the Police Department~~ adding a
5 certain position to the exempt service; providing for the pay applicable to the position
6 added to the exempt service; modifying the numbers, titles, and positions in the exempt
7 service in the Police Department approved as part of the annual budget and
8 appropriation ordinance; and generally relating to personnel.

1 SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,
2 That § 6-2-103(a)(21) through (33), respectively, of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005,
3 as amended) is hereby renumbered to be § 6-2-103(a)(22) through (34), respectively.

25 **6-2-103. Additional exempt positions.**

27 (a) Additional positions by title. In accordance with § 802(b) of the Charter the
28 positions described in this subsection are established as positions in the exempt service that
29 are in addition to the positions established by § 802(a) of the Charter, with the
30 compensation for the positions set forth in the exempt pay and benefit plan. Unless
31 otherwise provided by this subsection, the number of positions under each title described
32 in this subsection shall be approved as part of the annual budget and appropriation
33 ordinance and may not be changed during a fiscal year except as approved by ordinance of
34 the County Council. The positions are:

42 SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland
43 SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That, in accordance with § 6-2-103(a) of the Anne
44 Arundel County Code (2005, as amended), this Ordinance shall approve a decrease of one
45 Administrative Secretary to Department/Agency Head position in the Police Department
46 from the number of positions approved in the Police Department as part of the Annual
47 Budget and Appropriation Ordinance; and an increase of one Police Major (Exempt)
48 position, and one Police Chief of Staff position, and one Executive Assistant to the Chief


1 of Police position to the positions approved in the Police Department as part of the Annual
2 Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.

4 SECTION ~~2.4~~. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
5 from the date it becomes law.
