A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Positions in the Classified Service

2
3 FOR the purpose of decreasing a certain position in the classified service and increasing a
4 certain position in the classified service; and generally relating to personnel.

6 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
7 That, in accordance with § 6-1-110 of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended),
8 this Ordinance shall approve a decrease of one Assistant Director of Police position in the
9 Police Department from the number of positions approved in this classification in the
10 Police Department as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, and an
11 increase of one Police Fiscal Operations and Management Administrator position to the
12 positions approved in the Police Department as part of the Annual Budget and
13 Appropriation Ordinance.

15 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
16 from the date it becomes law.
