A participant of the Fire Service Retirement Plan, [[other than a Battalion Chief]] WHO IS IN THE 5 CLASSIFICATION OF FIRE DIVISION CHIEF, FIRE DEPUTY CHIEF, FIRE ASSISTANT CHIEF OR 6 FIRE CHIEF, or of the Police Service Retirement Plan who is in the classification of Police 7 Captain, Police Major, Policy Deputy Chief, or Police Chief must have the approval of the 8 appointing authority to extend the DROP participation period [[beyond the fifth year]] TO 9 A SIXTH YEAR. 10

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SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
from the date it becomes law.
