A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Zoning – 2022 Green Infrastructure Master Plan

2
3 FOR the purpose of repealing the 2002 Greenways Master Plan and amendments; adopting
4 the 2022 Green Infrastructure Master Plan and appendices as a guide for the future
5 conservation of natural lands in the County; making certain findings of fact and stating
6 the legislative intent relative to the Green Infrastructure Master Plan; adding an
7 applicability provision to Article 18 of the Code; making this Ordinance subject to a
8 certain contingency; providing for a special effective date in certain circumstances;
9 requiring a certain annual report; making a conforming change; and generally relating
10 to zoning and the County’s 2022 Green Infrastructure Master Plan.

1 WHEREAS, the County Council finds that, various plans and planning documents,
2 including the 2002 Greenways Master Plan, as amended, have been adopted by the
3 County Council; and

4
5 WHEREAS, the County Council further finds that “Plan2040”, the County’s
6 General Development Plan, as adopted by this Council on May 3, 2021, recognized
7 several Functional Master Plans, including the Green Infrastructure Master Plan,
8 which is intended to supersede and replace the 2002 Greenways Master Plan, as
9 amended; and

10
11 WHEREAS, the County Council finds the “Green Infrastructure Master Plan” is an
12 official policy document that is intended to guide conservation of an interconnected
13 network of the most significant remaining natural lands in Anne Arundel County;
14 protect water and air quality; provide habitats for plants and wildlife; create
15 opportunities for recreation and support mitigation of, and adaptation to, climate
16 change; and support the land use policies of the County’s General Development
17 Plan, “Plan2040,” by prioritizing areas for natural resource conservation, providing
18 open space, and maintaining rural character in the County; and

19
20 WHEREAS, the County Council finds that the Green Infrastructure Master Plan is
21 broad in scope rather than site-specific and is intended to outline a vision of how
22 the County will conserve and restore green spaces throughout the County, and does
23 not supersede planned land use described in Plan 2040 and any region plans adopted
24 pursuant thereto, and does not impose restrictions during any development review
25 process; and

26
27 WHEREAS, the County Council further finds that the Green Infrastructure Master
28 Plan is being updated to recognize and address inequity in environmental conditions
29 and access to green spaces in different parts of the County; and

30
31 WHEREAS, the County Council further finds that the Green Infrastructure Master
32 Plan provides an opportunity to conserve a connected network of natural lands as
33 envisioned in Maryland’s Green Infrastructure Assessment, the County’s General
34 Development Plan, “Plan2040”, Small Area Plans, and the Land Preservation,
35 Parks, and Recreation Plan; now, therefore

36
37 ~~SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*~~
38 ~~That the 2002 Greenways Master Plan, as amended, is hereby repealed.~~

40 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
41 That § 18-2-103(d) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) is hereby
42 renumbered to be § 18-2-103(e).

43
44 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the 2002 Greenways Master Plan, as
45 amended, is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2: 3. And be it further enacted, That the January 18, 2022 Green
2 Infrastructure Master Plan for Anne Arundel County is hereby amended as follows:

4 1. On page 12 of the Plan, at the end of the third paragraph, insert “The Green
5 Infrastructure Network Map is a conceptual map for planning purposes.”

6
7 2. On page 34, in the section entitled “2022 Green Infrastructure Network”, in the first
8 column, at the end of the paragraph, insert “The Green Infrastructure Network Map is a
9 conceptual planning map. Future land use or management decisions related to individual
10 parcels will be informed by site specific studies of greater detail and accuracy.”

11
12 3. On page 55, in section entitled “Action 3.2 Integrate the Green Infrastructure
13 Network Into County planning programs and procedures.”, in the third paragraph, in the
14 fifth line, after the period, insert “Delineation of the boundary of natural features will rely
15 on site specific studies, rather than the Network map.

16
17 SECTION 2: 3: 4. And be it further enacted, That the January 18, 2022 Green
18 Infrastructure Master Plan for Anne Arundel County, as amended by this Ordinance,
19 incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth, is hereby adopted.

20
21 SECTION 3: 4: 5. And be it further enacted, That a certified copy of the January 18,
22 2022 Green Infrastructure Master Plan for Anne Arundel County prepared by the Office of
23 Planning and Zoning, as amended by this Ordinance, shall be permanently kept on file in
24 the office of the Administrative Officer to the County Council and in the Office of Planning
25 and Zoning.

26
27 SECTION 4: 5: 6. And be it further enacted, That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel
28 County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

ARTICLE 18. ZONING

TITLE 2. GENERAL PROVISIONS

18-2-103. Planning for future development.

(D) Green Infrastructure Master Plan.

38 (1) THE 2022 GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE MASTER PLAN IS NOT REGULATORY, DOES
39 NOT HAVE THE FORCE OF LAW, AND DOES NOT IMPOSE RESTRICTIONS ON DEVELOPMENT
40 OR LAND USE IN THE COUNTY.

41
42 (2) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2023, AND ON OR BEFORE JULY 1 OF EVERY YEAR
43 FOLLOWING, THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND ZONING, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE
44 DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION AND PARKS, SHALL SUBMIT TO THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE
45 AND COUNTY COUNCIL A REPORT ON THE PROGRESS OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
46 GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE MASTER PLAN. IN COORDINATION WITH THE ANNUAL REPORT
47 THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND ZONING SHALL UPDATE THE GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE
48 NETWORK MAP TO:

50 (I) REMOVE ANY AREAS IDENTIFIED AS TECHNICAL ERRORS;

1 (II) DESIGNATE AREAS IN THE NETWORK WHERE DEVELOPMENT HAS BEEN
2 APPROVED;

3
4 (III) DESIGNATE AREAS IN THE NETWORK WHERE LAND HAS BEEN CONSERVED
5 THROUGH ACQUISITION, EASEMENT, OR SIMILAR MECHANISMS; AND

6
7 (IV) ADD ANY ADJACENT, CONTIGUOUS AREAS THAT HAVE BEEN CONSERVED
8 THROUGH ACQUISITION, EASEMENT, OR SIMILAR MECHANISMS.

10 **TITLE 11. REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIAL EXCEPTION USES**

11
12 **18-11-158. Solar energy generating facility – community.**

13
14 A solar energy generating facility – community shall comply with all of the following
15 requirements.

19 (4) Any solar facility where the fenced area would exceed 15 acres shall provide a
20 wildlife corridor conforming with the provisions of the current Anne Arundel County
21 [[Greenways]] GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE Master Plan.

25 ~~SECTION 5. 6. 7. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45~~
26 ~~days from the date it becomes law.~~

27
28 SECTION 7. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect contingent
29 upon the following:

30
31 1. Within 30 days of the enactment of this Ordinance, the Office of Planning and
32 Zoning shall mail each property newly included in the 2022 Green Infrastructure Master
33 Plan a notice of adoption of the 2022 Green Infrastructure Master Plan, including the
34 website for an interactive map showing the “2022 Green Infrastructure Network” which
35 allows searching of the map by address. The notice must request that property owners
36 whose property is included in the 2022 Green Infrastructure Network provide comments
37 within 60 days of the date of the notice indicating:

39 (a) whether the property is either “available for conservation” or “subject to
40 property owner plans”; and

41
42 (b) whether the Green Infrastructure Master Plan contains any errors.

43
44 2. Also within 30 days, the Office of Planning and Zoning shall post on the Office
45 of Planning and Zoning website a notice of adoption of the 2022 Green Infrastructure
46 Master Plan, including a link to an interactive map showing the “2022 Green Infrastructure
47 Network” which allows searching of the map by address. The notice must request that
48 property owners whose property is included in the 2022 Green Infrastructure Network
49 provide comments within 60 days of the date of the notice indicating:

1 (a) whether the property is either “available for conservation” or “subject to
2 property owner plans”; and

3
4 (b) whether the Green Infrastructure Master Plan contains any errors.

5
6 3. After the expiration of the 60 days, the Office of Planning and Zoning shall revise
7 the January 18, 2022 Green Infrastructure Master Plan to (a) indicate with a distinct
8 coloring or shading on the map of the 2022 Green Infrastructure Network, all the properties
9 which are:

10
11 (a) “subject to property owner plans” status of any property for according to
12 any comments received pursuant to Section 5-1 of this Ordinance; and

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14 (b) correct any errors accurately identified by property owner comments.

15
16 4. If the requirements of this Section are not met within a total of 180 days, this
17 Ordinance shall be null and void without further action of the County Council.



19 SECTION 8. And be it further enacted, That any ordinance that relies on the “2022
20 Green Infrastructure Network” may not take effect until the requirements of Section 7 of
21 this Ordinance have been met.

22
23 SECTION 9. And be it further enacted, That, subject to Section 7 of this Ordinance,
24 this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.


