A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Shoreham Beach Special Community Benefit District

3 FOR the purpose of revising the purposes of the Shoreham Beach Special Community  
4 Benefit District; correcting the name of the civic or community association that  
5 administers the district; and generally relating to the Shoreham Beach Special  
6 Community Benefit District.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 4-7-204(iii)(2) and (3)  
9 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

11 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*  
12 *Maryland,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as  
13 follows:

15 **ARTICLE 4. FINANCE, TAXATION, AND BUDGET**

17 **TITLE 7. SPECIAL COMMUNITY BENEFIT DISTRICTS, SHORE EROSION**  
18 **CONTROL DISTRICTS, AND WATERWAYS IMPROVEMENTS DISTRICTS**

20 **4-7-204. Districts established.**

22 **(iii) Shoreham Beach Special Community Benefit District.**

24 (2) The district is established for the purpose of PROVIDING FOR THE  
25 ACQUISITION, construction, maintenance, IMPROVEMENT, and repair of COMMUNITY

1 PROPERTY OR ANY AREA IN WHICH THE COMMUNITY HAS ANY INTEREST IN REAL  
 2 PROPERTY, AND COMMUNITY-WIDE PROJECTS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, [and  
 3 snow removal from, non-County-owned roads,] streets, PATHWAYS, EASEMENTS, alleys,  
 4 sidewalks, curbs, [street or road] signs, [street or road lights, bulkheads,] drainage  
 5 ditches, BOAT RAMPS, PIERS, GROINS, BULKHEADS, BREAKWATERS, AND LIGHTING[, and  
 6 culverts; maintenance of community areas; maintenance and improvement of real  
 7 property or any interest in real property necessary to accomplish community- wide  
 8 projects]; community security; SHORE EROSION CONTROL; and [defraying the] ANY  
 9 administrative costs incidental to the foregoing purposes, including [postage, auditing,  
 10 insurance, legal costs, and] THE repayment of any loan.

11  
 12 (3) The Shoreham Beach [Community] CITIZENS Association, Inc., a civic or  
 13 community association that meets the requirements of § 4-7-101(d), shall be responsible  
 14 for administering the Shoreham Beach Special Community Benefit District in furtherance  
 15 of the purposes of the district.

16  
 17 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect from the  
 18 date it becomes law.
