A BILL ENTITLED

1	AN ORDINANCE concerning: Sylvan Shores - Sanitary Subdistrict
2	
3	FOR the purpose of adding certain real properties to the Sylvan Shores Sanitary Subdistrict;
4	subjecting certain additional real properties to the provisions of Bill No. 75-11; providing
5	for the application of this Ordinance; and generally relating to the Sylvan Shores Sanitary
6	Subdistrict.

8	WHEREAS, Bill No. 75-11 established a Sylvan Shores Sanitary Subdistrict; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, Bill No. 75-11 was passed by the Anne Arundel County Council on
11	December 20, 2011, approved and enacted by the County Executive on December 28,
12	2011, and effective on February 11, 2012; and

14	WHEREAS, the boundaries of the Sylvan Shores Sanitary Subdistrict are set forth in
15	Exhibit A to Bill No. 75-11; and

17	WHEREAS, owners of nine thirteen real properties abutting the Sylvan Shores
18	Sanitary Subdistrict have submitted valid petitions to the County in accordance with §
19	13-5-303(a)(3) of the County Code to be included in the Sylvan Shores Sanitary
20	Subdistrict; and

WHEREAS, the real properties whose owners have petitioned to be included in the Sylvan Shores Sanitary Subdistrict currently are served by a private community water distribution system that is owned, operated and maintained by the Sylvan Shores Services Company, Inc.; and

 WHEREAS, seven eight of the real properties whose owners have petitioned to be included in the Sylvan Shores Sanitary Subdistrict currently are served by a private wastewater collection system that is owned, operated, and maintained by the Sylvan Shores Services Company, Inc.; and

 WHEREAS, two five of the real properties whose owners have petitioned to be included in the Sylvan Shores Sanitary Subdistrict already are connected to the County public wastewater system, with the lateral lines connecting those properties to the County public wastewater owned and maintained by the County; and

 WHEREAS, County Capital Project No. W803700 for construction of a water distribution system that will connect properties in the Sylvan Shores Sanitary Subdistrict to the County public water system, and Capital Project No. S803800 for replacement of the private wastewater collection system serving certain properties within the Sylvan Shores Sanitary Subdistrict with a public wastewater collection system to be owned and operated by the County, are underway; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with § 13-5-101(b) of the County Code the Director of Public Works recommends the addition of certain properties to the Sylvan Shores Sanitary Subdistrict and in the manner set forth in this Ordinance; now, therefore

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That certain properties be added to the Sylvan Shores Sanitary Subdistrict, the additional properties being shown on the map attached as Exhibit A Exhibit A1 hereto.

 SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the boundaries of the Sylvan Shores Sanitary Subdistrict be revised, the revised boundaries of which are set forth in Exhibit A Exhibit A1 hereto, and a certified copy of that map shall be permanently kept on file by the Administrative Officer to the County Council and the Office of Planning and Zoning, and a copy shall be included in the Anne Arundel County Master Plan for Water Supply & Sewerage Systems.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That Sections 3 through 14 of Bill No. 75-11 shall be applicable to the real properties added to the Sylvan Shores Sanitary Subdistrict.

SECTION 4. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall be construed to apply retroactively to the date of its introduction.

SECTION 5. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
