A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget - Board of
2 Education – Additional Appropriation and Transfers of Funds
3

4 FOR the purpose of transferring appropriations of funds between certain offices,
5 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies in the general fund;
6 making additional appropriations from unanticipated revenues to the Local Education
7 Fund for the current fiscal year; making this Ordinance an emergency measure; and
8 generally relating to transferring appropriations of funds and additional
9 appropriations to the current expense budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013.

11 BY amending: Current Expense Budget
12

13 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, the County Executive may
14 authorize transfers of funds within the same department and within the same fund;
15 and
16

17 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, upon recommendation of the
18 County Executive, the County Council may transfer funds between offices,
19 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies of the County
20 government and within the same fund of the Current Expense Budget; and
21

22 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the
23 County Executive, the County Council may make additional appropriations from
24 revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates and
25 from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget for the current
26 fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such
27 funds are available for appropriation; and

2 WHEREAS, § 5-105(a) of the Education Article of the Annotated Code of
3 Maryland, requires that all revenues received by the Board of Education be spent
4 in accordance with the major categories of its annual budget as provided under
5 §5-101 of the Education Article, and § 5-105(b) of the Education Article requires
6 that transfers between major categories be approved by the County Council; and
7

8 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the transfer of certain funds
9 and additional appropriations and the Controller has certified in writing that such
10 funds are available for appropriation; now, therefore,
11

12 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
13 *Maryland,* That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, be
14 and it is hereby amended by making supplemental appropriations of revenues received
15 from sources not anticipated in the budget and from revenues received from anticipated
16 sources in excess of budget estimates in the Local Education Fund as follows:

18	(1) Board of Education Local Revenues	\$ 1,025,000
19	(2) Federal & State Grants	\$ 3,203,400

21 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the Current Expense Budget for the
22 fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, is hereby amended by transferring funds from the
23 below-listed accounts in the Local Education Fund in the respective amounts set forth:
24

25	(1) Instructional Salaries & Wages	\$ 296,100
26	(2) Pupil Transportation	\$ 645,900
27	(3) Fixed Charges	\$ 4,871,400
28	(4) Community Services	\$ 800

30 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted,* That the Current Expense Budget for the
31 fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, is hereby amended by making supplemental
32 appropriations of such funds and by transferring such funds as enumerated in Sections 1
33 and 2 of this Ordinance to the below-listed accounts in the Local Education Fund in the
34 respective amounts set forth:



1 SECTION 4. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be
2 an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
3 peace, health, safety, welfare and property and, being passed by the affirmative vote of
4 five members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes
5 law.


