1	RESOLUTION recognizing June 9, 2015 as "Teal Tuesday - Tourette Syndrome
2	Awareness Day", and encouraging County residents to raise awareness of Tourette's
3	Syndrome and show support to children and families who live with Tourette's Syndrome.

5	WHEREAS, Tourette's Syndrome (TS) is an inherited neurological disorder
6	characterized by repetitive, stereotyped, involuntary movements and
7	vocalizations called tics, with an average onset age of 3 to 9 years old; and

9	WHEREAS, approximately 200,000 people in the United States have been
10	diagnosed with complex TS, with as many as 1 in 100 living in the greater
11	Baltimore/Annapolis area exhibiting symptoms of simple TS; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, although there is no known cure for TS, early diagnosis and
14	treatment are vital to diminishing the disorder's physical and psychological
15	effects; and

7	WHEREAS, increased public awareness and support by wearing the color teal
8	for Tourette's Awareness can help eliminate the social stigma attached to TS, as
9	well as offer insight to the estimated thousands of Americans who remain
20	untreated or undiagnosed; and

22	WHEREAS, Caroline Christian, age 15, of Severna Park, Miss Anne Arundel
23	County Outstanding Teen 2015, and a National Tourette Syndrome Youth
24	Ambassador, diagnosed with TS since second grade, has encouraged all citizens
