SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That § 7-6-101(a)(10) through (89) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) is hereby renumbered to be § 7-6-101(a)(11) through (90), respectively.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

ARTICLE 6. PERSONNEL

TITLE 1. CLASSIFIED SERVICE

6-1-201. Titles; pay grades; work weeks; minimum qualifications.

(d) **Title, pay grades, work week, and minimum qualifications.** The title, minimum standards, pay grade, and the work week designation that an employee is required to follow for each class within the classified service are as follows:

(8) Public Safety and Criminal Justice (PS).

Title ***	Grade and Work Week	Minimum Qualifications
[Director of Emergency Management	NR19C	Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in public or business administration; considerable experience in emergency management; and a valid non-commercial Class C motor vehicle operator's license]

TITLE 2. EXEMPT SERVICE

6-2-101. Exempt pay and benefit plan.

(a) **Pay grades.** The following officers and employees in the exempt service of the County are entitled to compensation at the indicated pay grade:

6-2-103. Additional exempt positions.

28	of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended), this Ordinance shall approve a		
29	decrease of one position of Director of Emergency Management in the Classified Service in		
30	the Fire Department from the positions approved in this classification as part of the Annual		
31	Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, and an increase in the Exempt Service of one position		
32	of Emergency Management Director to the positions in the Exempt Service in the Fire		
33	Department approved as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.		
34	SECTION 3. 4. And be it further enacted, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall		
35	apply to the first pay period beginning on or after July 1, 2015.
