1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Classified Service; Exempt Service – Emergency  
2 Management Director

4 FOR the purpose of eliminating a certain position from the classified service; adding a  
5 certain position to the exempt service; providing for the pay, pension, and financial  
6 disclosure requirements applicable to the position added to the exempt service; providing  
7 for the applicability of this Ordinance; and generally relating to personnel.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: §§ 6-1-201(d)(8); 6-2-101(a); and 6-2-  
10 103(a)  
11 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

13 BY renumbering: § 7-6-101(a)(10) through (89) to be § 7-6-101(a)(11) through (90),  
14 respectively

1 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
 2 That § 7-6-101(a)(10) through (89) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) is  
 3 hereby renumbered to be § 7-6-101(a)(11) through (90), respectively.

5 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County  
 6 Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

 15 standards, pay grade, and the work week designation that an employee is required to follow  
 16 for each class within the classified service are as follows:

 24 **6-2-101. Exempt pay and benefit plan.**

 26 (a) **Pay grades.** The following officers and employees in the exempt service of the  
 27 County are entitled to compensation at the indicated pay grade:

33 **6-2-103. Additional exempt positions.**

 35 (a) **Additional positions by title.** In addition to the positions established in § 802 of the  
 36 Charter for the exempt service, there are the following positions in the exempt service whose  
 37 number and classification are approved as part of the annual budget and appropriation

27 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted, that, in accordance with §§ 6-1-110 and 6-2-103*  
28 *of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended), this Ordinance shall approve a*  
29 *decrease of one position of Director of Emergency Management in the Classified Service in*  
30 *the Fire Department from the positions approved in this classification as part of the Annual*  
31 *Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, and an increase in the Exempt Service of one position*  
32 *of Emergency Management Director to the positions in the Exempt Service in the Fire*  
33 *Department approved as part of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance.*

34  
35 SECTION 3- 4. *And be it further enacted, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall*  
36 *apply to the first pay period beginning on or after July 1, 2015.*

37  
38 SECTION 4- 5. *And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days*  
39 *from the date it becomes law.*


