Chief, Telecommunication Services	[NR21C] NR23C	Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university in business or public administration, supplemented by course work in engineering; considerable experience in management of telecommunications facilities and systems for government organizations, including supervisory experience and related computer applications experience; and a valid non-commercial Class C motor vehicle operator's license

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the provisions of this Ordinance shall be construed to apply retroactively to the first full pay period that began on or after July 1, 2015.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
