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4 FOR the purpose of altering the pay grade for the position of Chief, Telecommunication  
5 Services, in the classified service; providing for the applicability of this Ordinance; and  
6 generally relating to personnel.

11 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*

Chief, Telecommunication Services	[NR21C] NR23C	Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university in business or public administration, supplemented by course work in engineering; considerable experience in management of telecommunications facilities and systems for government organizations, including supervisory experience and related computer applications experience; and a valid non-commercial Class C motor vehicle operator's license
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SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the provisions of this Ordinance shall be construed to apply retroactively to the first full pay period that began on or after July 1, 2015.

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
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SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.

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


