17	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,
18	That § 5-1-508(d) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) is hereby
19	renumbered to be § 5-1-508(e).

21	SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County
22	Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

ARTICLE 5 PENSIONS 1 2 TITLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS 3 4 5 5-1-503. Eligibility 6 (a) Fire Service Retirement Plan. [Except as provided in subsection (b), a] A participant 7 in the Fire Service Retirement Plan is eligible to participate in the DROP if the participant is 8 actively employed by the County in a position covered by the plan and has completed 20 years 9 of actual plan service. 10 11 [(b) Fire Service Retirement Plan after January 1, 2015. After January 1, 2015, an 12 employee in the classification of Fire Battalion Chief will not be eligible to participate in 13 DROP. 14 15 (c)] (B) Police Service Retirement Plan. A participant in the Police Service Retirement 16 Plan is eligible to participate in the DROP if the participant is actively employed by the 17 County in a position covered by this plan and has completed 20 years of actual plan service. 18 19 20 5-1-506. Participation period; mandatory retirement upon expiration. 21 (b) Term of participation period. The initial term of a DROP participation period is 22 three years, FOR PARTICIPANTS WHO ARE EMPLOYEES REPRESENTED BY THE INTERNATIONAL 23 ASSOCIATION OF FIREFIGHTERS, LOCAL 1563 [The] THE DROP participation period may be 24 extended by no more than two additional one-year terms, AND THE DROP PARTICIPATION 25 PERIOD MAY BE EXTENDED BY NO MORE THAN THREE ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR TERMS FOR 26 ALL OTHER PARTICIPANTS WHO QUALIFY FOR PARTICIPATION IN DROP UNDER §5-1-503. A 27 DROP participant shall file an election for each extension on the form required by the 28 Personnel Officer no fewer than 30 days before the end of the current term. Failure of a 29 DROP participant to file a timely election for an extension results in the expiration of the 30 DROP participation period at the end of the current term. 31 32 5-1-508. DROP account. 33 34 (c) Account Balance. The account balance credited to a DROP participant includes: 35 36 (1) the amount of the retirement benefit determined under subsection (b); and 37 38 (2) interest on [that amount] AMOUNTS EARNED IN YEARS ONE THROUGH FIVE OF A 39 MEMBER'S DROP PARTICIPATION: 40 41 (i) compounded on the account balance as of the first day of each month; 42 43 (ii) for members of the Police Service RETIREMENT Plan whose DROP 44 participation began prior to July 1, 2009, at an interest rate of 0.6434%, which provides an 45 effective annual yield of 8%;

1 2 3	(iii) for members of the Police Service RETIREMENT Plan whose DROP participation began after June 30, 2009, at an interest rate of .34745%, which provides an effective annual yield of 4.25%;
4 5 6 7	(iv) for members of the Fire Service RETIREMENT Plan whose DROP participation began prior to July 1, 2010, at an interest rate of 0.6434%, which provides [and] AN effective annual yield of 8%; AND
8 9 10 11	(v) for members of the Fire Service RETIREMENT Plan whose DROP participation began after June 30, 2010, at an interest rate of .34745%, which provides an effective annual yield of 4.25%[; and
12 13 14 15	(vi) credited to the DROP participant from the beginning to the expiration of the DROP participation period].
16 17 18 19	(D) Limitations on interest. NO INTEREST WILL BE EARNED OR CREDITED DURING THE SIXTH YEAR OF A DROP PARTICIPATION PERIOD OR AFTER THE EXPIRATION OF ANY DROP PARTICIPATION PERIOD.
20 21 22 23	SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare, and property, and being passed by the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law.
