11	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,
12	That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

14	ARTICLE 13. PUBLIC WORKS

16	TITLE 5. UTILITIES

18	13-5-813. Water and wastewater system connection charges and assessments.
19	
20	(l) Properties exempt from capital facility connection charges. Religious facilities,
21	parsonages, housing for the elderly of moderate means, incorporated nonprofit community
22	association facilities, STRUCTURES FOR NONPROFIT VETERANS AND MILITARY SERVICE
23	ORGANIZATIONS EXEMPT FROM TAXATION UNDER SECTION 501(C)(19) OF THE INTERNAL
24	REVENUE CODE WITH A RATED CAPACITY OF 500 PEOPLE OR FEWER PURSUANT TO THE FIRE

PREVENTION CODE, and nonprofit educational structures are exempt from capital facility connection charges.
