## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning: Public Works – Landfills
FOR the purpose of requiring recyclable materials to be separated from trash or other
waste matter when disposed at County landfills and solid waste disposal facilities;
prohibiting the disposal of recyclable materials with trash or other waste matter;
establishing certain sanctions; establishing certain sanctions; and generally related to
landfills.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,
Maryland, That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as
follows:
<b>ARTICLE 13. PUBLIC WORKS</b>
EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate new matter added to existing law.
[Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.
<u>Underlining</u> indicates amendments to bill. Strikeover indicates matter stricken from bill by amendment.

(c) Requirements and prohibitions. All solid waste shall be contained or covered so as to avoid the loss of waste from the vehicle during transportation and the creation of litter. A person may not dispose of solid waste that originates or is generated outside the County and may not dispose of off-the-road equipment tires or combustion ash. RECYCLABLE MATERIALS SHALL BE SEPARATED FROM TRASH OR OTHER WASTE BEFORE DISPOSAL, AND A PERSON MAY NOT WILLFULLY DISPOSE OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS WITH TRASH OR OTHER WASTE MATTER. FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100. SUBSECTION (C) IS A CLASS E CIVIL OFFENSE. SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
