6	WHEREAS, Anne Arundel County, Maryland (the "County") recognizes that there
7 8	is a need for reinvestment and revitalization of certain communities in the Brooklyn Park area of Anne Arundel County; and

22	Office of Planning and Zoning, and Anne Arundel Economic Development Corporation ("AAEDC") and its partners, including Strong City Baltimore, propose
23	to continue activities in the Brooklyn Park Sustainable Community Area, the
24	purpose of which will be to contribute to reinvestment and revitalization in the Area
25 26	and to provide affordable housing opportunities for the County's workforce ("the Project"); and

28	WHEREAS, Strong City Baltimore, a regional planning consultant, is applying to
29	the Department, and the Department, either through the Baltimore Regional
30 31	Neighborhood Initiative, Community Legacy Program, or other programs of the
32	Department, or in cooperation with other State departments or agencies, may provide some or all of the financing for the Project (the "Project Financing") in
