A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Licenses – Construction Trade Licenses – Utility
2 Contractors

4 FOR the purpose of amending the scope of a utility contractor license to allow work
5 on a single family dwelling water distribution, sewerage, or storm drain system,
6 or component part, that connects to a public system; removing the requirement
7 that a licensed plumber perform the connection from the structure to the system;
8 and generally related to construction trade licenses

13 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
14 *Maryland,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as
15 follows:

19 **TITLE 4. CONSTRUCTION TRADE LICENSES**

21 **11-4-604. Utility contractor.**

23 (a) **Scope of license.** A licensed utility contractor may construct, alter, repair, or
24 modify a private water distribution system, private sewerage system or private storm

1 drain system or any component part of these systems that connects to a public system
2 beginning at the boundary line of the property on which the work is performed to five
3 feet from an exterior wall of any structure on the property[, with the exception of a
4 single-family dwelling. The physical connection from the structure to the system shall be
5 made by a licensed plumber].

7 SECTION 2. *Be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from
8 the date it becomes law.
