A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Additional Appropriations –  
2 Health Department

3  
4 FOR the purpose of making additional appropriations from unanticipated revenues to  
5 certain offices, departments, institutions, boards, commissions, or other agencies in  
6 the Grants Special Revenue Fund of the County for the current fiscal year.

7  
8 BY amending: Current Expense Budget

9  
10 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the  
11 County Executive, the County Council may make additional appropriations from  
12 revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget or from revenues  
13 received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates for the current  
14 fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such  
15 funds are available for appropriation; and

17 WHEREAS, the County has received grant funds from a source not anticipated in  
18 the budget in the amount of \$228,000 from the Maryland Department of Health  
19 and Mental Hygiene, Behavioral Health Administration; and

20  
21 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended appropriation of these funds  
22 to the Grants Special Revenue Fund for expenditure by the Health Department,  
23 and the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for  
24 appropriation; now, therefore,

26 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*  
27 *Maryland,* That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, be

1 and it is hereby amended by making supplemental appropriations from revenues received  
2 from a source not anticipated in the budget in the total amount of \$ 228,000 to the Grants  
3 Special Revenue Fund, as follows:


13 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days




