## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget - Transfer of Funds and 1 Supplementary Appropriations 2 3 FOR the purpose of transferring appropriations of funds between certain offices, 4 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies in the general fund; 5 making supplementary appropriations from unanticipated revenues to certain funds in 6 the budget for the current fiscal year; and generally relating to transferring 7 appropriations of funds and making supplementary appropriations of funds to the 8 current expense budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018. 9 10 BY amending: Current Expense Budget 11 12 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, the County Executive may 13 authorize transfers of funds within the same department and within the same fund; 14 15 and 16 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, upon recommendation of the 17 County Executive, the County Council may transfer funds between offices. 18 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies of the County 19 government and within the same fund of the Current Expense Budget; and 20 21 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the 22 County Executive, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations 23 from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget or from revenues 24 received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates for the current 25

fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such funds 1 are available for appropriation; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended transfer and supplementary 4 appropriations of certain funds, and the Controller has certified in writing that such 5 funds are available for appropriation; now, therefore, 6 7 SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, 8 That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, be and it is 9 hereby amended by transferring an appropriation of funds from the below-listed 10 department in the amount set forth: 11 12 (1) Chief Administrative Officer – General Fund Appropriation 13 Contingency 14 \$ 2,232,700 \$ 2,254,200 Grants, Contributions & Other 15 16 and by transferring and adding such appropriation of funds to the below-listed department 17 in the respective amounts set forth: 18 19 (1) Health Department - General Fund Appropriation 20 Behavioral Health Services 21 <del>232,700</del> 59,000 Contractual Services 22 23 (2) Department of Public Works - General Fund Appropriation 24 Bureau of Highways 25 \$ 400,000 Personal Services 26 \$ 1,000,000 Contractual Services 27 \$ 600,000 Supplies & Materials 28 29 (3) Police Department 30 Admin Services 31 \$ 195,200 Supplies & Materials 32 33 SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal 34 year ending June 30, 2018, be and it is hereby amended by making supplementary 35 appropriations from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget or from 36 revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates as follows: 37 38 (1) Unappropriated fund balance of the 39 Video Lottery Facility Local Impact Grant Special Revenue Fund \$ 270,000 40 41 and by adding such funds to the below-listed funds, in the respective amounts set forth: 42 43 (1) Video Lottery Facility Local Impact Grant Special Revenue Fund 44 County Executive 45 **VLT Community Grants** 46
