A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Finance and Taxation – Commercial Revitalization
2 District Program
3
4 FOR the purpose of extending the expiration date of the Commercial Revitalization
5 District Program, formerly titled the Community Revitalization Program, established
6 by Bill No. 97-01 and amended by Bill No. 94-06 and Bill No. 4-12

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: Bill No. 97-01, Section 3 Laws of Anne
9 Arundel County, 2002 as amended by Bill No. 94-06, Section 1, Laws of Anne
10 Arundel County 2006; and Bill No. 4-12, Section 1, Laws of Anne Arundel County
11 2012

13 WHEREAS, Bill No. 97-01, now codified as § 4-2-306, Commercial
14 Revitalization District Program, of the Anne Arundel County Code, established a
15 community revitalization program in certain areas allowing taxpayers that
16 revitalize their commercially or industrially zoned properties or mobile home
17 parks to receive a certain property tax credit, and provides that those amendments
18 shall end five years from the effective date of Bill No. 97-01; and

20 WHEREAS, Bill No. 94-06 extended the termination of the program until April
21 20, 2012; and

23 WHEREAS, Bill No. 4-12 extended the termination of the program until April 20,
24 2017; and

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate new matter added to existing law.
[Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.

1 WHEREAS, the Commercial Revitalization District Program originally
2 established by Bill No. 97-01 has been beneficial for Anne Arundel County and
3 its citizens and continues to be beneficial and therefore the County Council
4 believes these benefits regarding the Commercial Revitalization District Program
5 should be continued; now, therefore

7 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
8 *Maryland,* That the Laws of Anne Arundel County, 2002, Bill No. 97-01, Section 3,
9 as amended by the Laws of Anne Arundel County 2006, Bill No. 94-06, Section 1
10 and by the Laws of Anne Arundel County 2012, Bill No. 4-12, Section 1 be and they
11 are hereby amended to read as follows:

13 Bill No. 97-01

15 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted,* that the provisions of this Ordinance
16 shall remain in effect for [five] [10] [15] 20 years from the date this Ordinance
17 becomes effective, after which it shall stand repealed and be of no further force
18 and effect, except for applications for a revitalization credit that are submitted to
19 the Controller prior to the effective date this Ordinance is repealed.

21 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
22 from the date it becomes law.
