A BILL ENTITLED

1	AN ORDINANCE concerning: Solar Energy Power Purchase Agreements - Annapolis Solar
2	Park, LLC
3	
4	FOR the purpose of approving Solar Energy Power Purchase Agreements between Annapolis
5	Solar Park, LLC and Anne Arundel County, Maryland to provide for the purchase by the
6	County of energy output from solar facilities constructed, owned, and operated by
7	Annapolis Solar Park, LLC on property leased by Annapolis Solar Park, LLC from the
8	City of Annapolis under the terms and conditions contained in the Solar Energy Power
9	Purchase Agreements; and generally relating to the Solar Energy Power Purchase
10	Agreements.

12	WHEREAS, Annapolis Solar Park, LLC ("Annapolis Solar"), a Delaware limited
13	liability company, has leased property from the City of Annapolis at the closed
14	Annapolis Landfill, located in the vicinity of Interstate 97, Maryland Route 450, and
15	Crownsville Road, in Anne Arundel County; and

17	WHEREAS, Annapolis Solar intends to construct, own, and operate three
18	photovoltaic generating facilities, each with a generating capacity of approximately
19	two megawatts AC, designated as 470 Defense Highway, Park 3, Park 4, and Park 5,
20	respectively; and

22	WHEREAS, the County Executive proposes to enter into a Solar Energy Power
23	Purchase Agreement (the "Agreements") for each of the three photovoltaic
24	generating facilities through which the County will purchase all of the energy output
25	from the facilities under the terms and conditions of contained in the Agreements;

WHEREAS, the Agreements require that they be approved by ordinance of the 1 2 County Council as a condition precedent to their effectiveness; and 3 4 WHEREAS, entering into the Solar Energy Power Purchase Agreements is in the best interests of the County; now therefore 5 6 7 SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the Solar Energy Power Purchase Agreement related to the facility designated as 470 8 Defense Highway, Park 3, incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth, is approved. 9 10 SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the Solar Energy Power Purchase 11 Agreement related to the facility designated as 470 Defense Highway, Park 4, incorporated 12 herein by reference as if fully set forth, is approved. 13 14 15 SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That the Solar Energy Power Purchase Agreement related to the facility designated as 470 Defense Highway, Park 5, incorporated 16 herein by reference as if fully set forth, is approved. 17 18 19 SECTION 4. And be it further enacted, That the County Executive or his authorized designee is hereby authorized on behalf of the County to execute and deliver the Agreement 20 in substantially the same form hereby approved with (i) such changes in form or such 21 changes in content which do not materially adversely affect the interests of the County, and 22 (ii) such other changes as may be approved by resolution or resolutions of the County 23 Council. 24 25 SECTION 5. And be it further enacted, That copies of the Solar Energy Power Purchase 26 Agreements shall be kept permanently on file with the Administrative Officer to the County 27 Council. 28 29 SECTION 6. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days 30 from the date it becomes law. READ AND PASSED this 6th day of March, 2017
