A BILL ENTITLED

1	AN ORDINANCE concerning: Purchasing - Acquisition of real property by gift
2	
3	FOR the purpose of approving acceptance of a gift of real property consisting of
4 5	approximately 23,249.72 square feet or 0.533 acres, being a part of the surplus property conveyed to Watts Avenue, L.C. from Anne Arundel County, Maryland.
6	conveyed to watts Avenue, E.C. from Anne Artificer County, Maryland.
7	WHEREAS, Section 306 of the Anne Arundel County Charter empowers the
8	County Council to accept gifts and grants on behalf of Anne Arundel County,
9	Maryland (the "County"); and
10	
11	WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 19-13, the County Council of Anne
12	Arundel County, Maryland approved the County Executive's determination that
13	certain County owned property comprising 29,975 square feet or 0.688 acres
14	located in Stoney Run Village, Hanover, Maryland, was surplus property ("Surplus
15	Property"); and
16	
17	WHEREAS, Watts Avenue, L.C. acquired the Surplus Property from the County
8	pursuant to a Deed recorded among the Land Records of Anne Arundel County,
9	Maryland in liber 26764, folio 270; and

21	WHEREAS, the parties have determined that a portion of the Surplus Property
22	comprising 23,249.72 square feet or 0.533 acres, as depicted on Exhibit A, attached
23	hereto and made a part hereof, was inadvertently included as part of the Surplus
24	Property transferred to Watts Avenue, L.C. ("Excess Watts Avenue Surplus
2.5	Property"); and

.7	WHEREAS, the Excess Watts Avenue Surplus Property is more specifically
8	described as follows:

BEING a strip or parcel of land hereinafter described in the 4th Assessment District for Anne Arundel County, Maryland, running in, through, over and across the property acquired by Tavenshire, L.C. from the Washington District Advisory Board of the Church of the Nazerine, Inc., by deed dated October 30, 2000 and recorded among the land records of Anne Arundel County, Maryland in Liber 10021 at Folio 603, said strip or parcel of land being part of the land known and identified as Relocated Watts Avenue as shown on a subdivision record plat entitled "Plat 3 of 6, Stoney Run Village" and recorded among the aforesaid Land Records in Book 117, Page No. 45, as Plat No. E6045, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING for the said strip or parcel of land on the (3rd) or North 89° 52' 24" West, 541.63 feet line as described in the aforesaid deed, distance, 19.83 feet from the end thereof, running thence with and binding on the outline of said deed, the following courses and distances.

1. North 89° 52' 24" West 19.83 feet to a point on the westerly or North 06° 41' 24" West 222.04 feet right-of-way line of said Relocated Watts Avenue as shown on said Plat No. E6045, running thence with and binding on said right-of-way.

2. North 06° 41' 24" West 222.04 feet to a point thence;

3. North 02° 39' 00" West 25.53 feet thence;

4. North 03° 48' 36" East 9.01 feet thence;

5. North 16° 47' 36" East 16.67 feet to a point on the South 83° 25' 25" East 67.62 foot line as shown on a plat of WATTS VILLAGE said plat recorded among the land records of Anne Arundel County, Maryland in Plat Book 345 pages 19-21 thence running with and binding on said plat the following three courses.

6. South 83 ° 25' 25" East 51.98 feet to a point thence;

7. North 42° 16' 11" East 98.58 feet to a point thence;

8. 56.36 feet along the arc of a curve, deflecting to the left, having a radius of 196.00 feet and a chord bearing and distance of North 34° 02' 10" East 56.17 feet to a point thence;

9. 76.88 feet along the arc of a curve, deflecting to the left, having a radius of 425.97 feet and a chord bearing and distance of North 70° 38' 37" East 76.78 feet to a point thence;

10. 128.46 feet along the arc of a curve, deflecting to the right,

2	of South 27° 53' 38" West 127.12 feet thence;
3	11 South 42° 16' 11" West 119 64 fact to a point thereon
5	11. South 42° 16' 11" West 118.64 feet to a point thence;
6	12. 175.22 feet along a curve, deflecting to the left, having a radius
7	of 196.00 feet and a chord bearing and distance of South 16° 32'
8	32" West 169.44 feet to a point thence;
9	32 West 103.11 feet to a point thence,
10	13. South 08° 57" 06" East 48.13 feet to the point of beginning.

12	Containing 23,249.72 square feet or 0.533 acres more or less.

14	AND BEING a part of those lands in a deed conveyed by Anne Arundel
15	County, Maryland, a body corporate and politic of the State of Maryland to
16	Watts Avenue, LC, a Maryland limited liability company by deed dated
17	October 10, 2013 and recorded in the land records of Anne Arundel County,
18	Maryland in Liber 26764, Folio 270.

22	WHEREAS, Watts Avenue, L.C. desires to convey the Excess Watts Avenue
23	Surplus Property to the County; and
24	WHEREAG :
25	WHEREAS, in accordance with § 8-3-101(b)(1) of the County Code, the County
26 27	Executive has identified a public purpose for the Property, in that it will be used for
28	a public right-of-way; and
29	WHEREAS, in accordance with § 8-3-101(b)(2) of the County Code, the County
30	Executive ensured that the Director of Public Works conducted an environmental
31	assessment and provided a written determination of any potential hazard or future
32	remediation expense, which determination is acceptable; and
33	
34	WHEREAS, in accordance with § 8-3-101(b)(3) of the County Code, the County
35	Executive ensured that the Budget Officer provided a written assessment of the
36	fiscal impact of the proposed gift, including any impact on future expenditures,
37	which assessment is acceptable; now, therefore,

39	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,
40	That it accepts the gift of fee simple title to the Excess Watts Avenue Surplus Property
41	consisting of 23,249.72 square feet or 0.533 acres of real property as described herein and
42	depicted in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof;

44	SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
45	from the date it becomes law.


