A BILL ENTITLED

1	AN ORDINANCE concerning: Administrative Zoning Reclassifications - Temporary
2	Moratorium
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4	FOR the purpose of establishing a temporary moratorium on administrative zoning
5	reclassifications in Anne Arundel County, Maryland; providing for the application of
6	this Ordinance; and generally relating to zoning.
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8	WHEREAS, the County Executive and the Office of Planning and Zoning are
9	engaged in a comprehensive review of the County's 2009 General Development
10	Plan and the drafting of a new General Development Plan, which will be followed
11	by the comprehensive zoning process in 2020; and
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13	WHEREAS, the review and drafting of the new General Development Plan and the
14	implementation of the comprehensive zoning process will be greatly impacted if
15	changes in administrative zoning classifications are permitted during the time the
16	General Development Plan and comprehensive zoning are being considered; and
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18	WHEREAS, as recognized by the United States Supreme Court in the 2002 case of
19	Tahoe-Sierra Preservation Council v. Tahoe Regional Planning Agency, temporary
20	moratoriums are a common and valid tool throughout the country and are imposed
21	during the review and revision of comprehensive land use plans to maintain the
22	status quo while land use patterns are analyzed; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That a temporary moratorium on the acceptance of applications for administrative zoning reclassifications for properties in all Councilmanic Districts is hereby established, which moratorium shall continue in each District until 90 days after the date upon which a draft General Development Plan is submitted to the Planning Advisory Board or January 1, 2020, whichever occurs first. until the introduction of an ordinance that adopts the General Development Plan, whichever comes first, but not later than July 1, 2020.

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SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the moratorium created by this Ordinance shall apply to applications for administrative rezoning reclassifications submitted on or after September 1, 2018 July 15, 2018.

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SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
