4 Districts; and generally related to zoning.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 18-5-102
7 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

9 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
10 *Maryland,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as
11 follows:

13 **ARTICLE 18. ZONING**

15 **TITLE 5. COMMERCIAL DISTRICTS**

17 **18-5-102. Permitted, conditional, special exception, and business complex auxiliary**
18 **uses.**

19 The permitted, conditional, and special exception uses allowed in each of the
20 commercial districts, and uses auxiliary to a business complex, are listed in the chart in
21 this section using the following key: P = permitted use; C = conditional use; SE = special
22 exception use; and A = auxiliary to a business complex use. A blank means that the use is
23 not allowed in the district. Except as provided otherwise in this article, uses and
24 structures customarily accessory to permitted, conditional, and special exception uses
25 also are allowed.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate new matter added to existing law.
[Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.




