## 13-1-106. Disposal of personal property on County property.

(b) **Removal by County.** The Department may remove and dispose of all personal property that is on County property in violation of this section, and the Department shall bill the owner of the rental real property for all costs incurred by the County in connection with the removal and disposal of the evicted tenant's personal property, including overhead and administrative costs. The [costs] OWNER OF THE RENTAL REAL PROPERTY shall [be] PAY THE BILL WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE BILL, AND ANY AMOUNT UNPAID 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE BILL SHALL BE collected as provided in § 1-8-101 of this Code.

#### TITLE 2. ROADS

## 13-2-205. Improvement of sidewalks; sidewalk assessments.

(d) **Failure to comply.** If a property owner fails to comply with a final notice within the time specified in the notice, the Director may procure the performance of the work by the County work force or by contract. The cost and expense of the work, including overhead and administrative costs, shall be certified to the Controller, together with the names of the owners of the property in front of which the work was done[. The amount], AND THE AMOUNT SHALL BE BILLED TO THE PROPERTY OWNERS. THE PROPERTY OWNERS SHALL PAY THE BILL WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE BILL, AND ANY AMOUNT UNPAID 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE BILL shall be collected as provided in § 1-8-101 of this Code.

#### TITLE 5. UTILITIES

### 13-5-601. Authority to impose; liability; lien.

(c) **Collection.** Front foot assessments shall be PAID WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DUE DATE ON THE BILLING INVOICE, AND ANY AMOUNT UNPAID 30 DAYS AFTER THE DUE DATE SHALL BE collected as provided in § 1-8-101 of this Code.

#### 13-5-702. Liability.

 The owners of real property, including the County, who connect the water or wastewater facilities of the property with the water or wastewater facilities of the County or whose property is benefited by the water or wastewater facilities of the County shall pay the applicable special benefit charges. The charges shall be PAID WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DUE DATE ON THE BILLING INVOICE, AND ANY AMOUNT UNPAID 30 DAYS AFTER THE DUE DATE SHALL BE collected as provided in § 1-8-101 of this Code.

## 13-6-105. Notice to remove and removal.

 (d) **Costs.** The cost and expense of the work by the County, including overhead and administrative costs, SHALL BE BILLED TO THE PROPERTY OWNER AND SHALL BE PAID WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE BILL, AND ANY AMOUNT UNPAID 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE BILL shall be collected as provided in § 1-8-101 of this Code.

#### 16-4-303. Maintenance.

(c) Immediate danger. If, on inspection by the Department, the condition of a stormwater management practice presents an immediate danger to the public health, safety, or the natural environment because of an unsafe condition or improper maintenance, the Department shall take such action as may be necessary to protect the public and make the practice safe. Any cost incurred by the County shall be [assessed against the owner,] BILLED TO THE PROPERTY OWNER AND SHALL BE PAID WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE BILL, AND ANY AMOUNT UNPAID 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE BILL SHALL BE COLLECTED as provided in § 1-8-101 of this Code.

## 16-4-401. Private stormwater management.

(c) Liability for cost of work performed by the Department. The cost of work performed by the Department under the provisions of this section shall be [levied and] BILLED TO THE PROPERTY OWNER AND SHALL BE PAID WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE BILL, AND ANY AMOUNT UNPAID AFTER 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE BILL SHALL BE collected as provided in § 1-8-101 of this Code.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the Anne Arundel County Construction and Property Maintenance Codes Supplement, October 1, 2005 (as amended) (and as amended by Bill No. 71-16) read as follows:

#### **CONSTRUCTION CODE**

## Chapter 1 Construction Code Administrative Provisions

## Section 115 Unsafe Structures, Systems, and Equipment

115.6 Disregard of unsafe notice. On the failure of a person served with an unsafe notice to comply with the requirements of the notice, the Code Official may refer the case to the County Attorney for appropriate action to correct the violation, including repair or demolition at the expense of the owner. The cost of such actions shall constitute a lien on the land and improvements, and the [lien may] COSTS SHALL BE BILLED TO THE PROPERTY OWNER AND PAID WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE BILL, AND ANY AMOUNT UNPAID AFTER 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THE BILL SHALL be enforced pursuant to section § 1-8-101 of this Code.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
