A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Capital Budget and Program – Rock Creek Aerator – Fund
2 Transfer

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Capital Budget by transferring appropriation of funds
5 from the CSX DMP Site Restoration, Rock Creek DMP Restoration, Rockhold Crk
6 County Dredging, Duvall Creek Dredging, Marley Creek Dredging, and Upper
7 Magothy River Dredging capital projects to the Rock Creek Aerator capital project;
8 and amending the Capital Program and Capital Projects Bond Ordinance.

10 BY amending: Capital Budget
11 Capital Program
12 Capital Projects Bond Ordinance

14 WHEREAS, the Rock Creek Aerator capital project, Project No. C560500, has an
15 existing appropriation; and
16

17 WHEREAS, Section 716 of the Charter authorizes the County Council, upon
18 request of the County Executive and by the affirmative vote of five members of the
19 County Council, to amend the capital budget; and
20

21 WHEREAS, Section 711(b) of the Charter authorizes the County Council, upon
22 request of the County Executive, to transfer appropriations between capital projects
23 in the Capital Budget; and

25 WHEREAS, the County Executive is requesting that a total of \$438,000 be
26 transferred from the CSX DMP Site Restoration capital project, Project No.
27 D562500, the Rock Creek DMP Restoration capital project, Project No. D562600,
28 the Rockhold Crk County Dredging capital project, Project No. D562700, the

1 Duvall Creek Dredging capital project, Project No. Q548200, the Marley Creek
2 Dredging capital project, Project No. Q567700, and the Upper Magothy River
3 Dredging capital project, Project No. Q570400, to the Rock Creek Aerator capital
4 project, Project No. C560500; and

6 WHEREAS, the Planning Advisory Board has recommended amendments to the
7 Capital Budget in accordance with Section 716 of the Charter; and
8

9 WHEREAS, the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for
10 appropriation; and
11

12 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
13 that the Capital Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, is hereby amended by
14 transferring appropriations in the total amount \$438,000 from the following capital
15 projects:

20 Rock Creek DMP Restoration, Project No. D562600
21 (General County Bonds) \$ 71,000

27 (General County Bonds) \$ 75,000



45 date it becomes law.


