A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget - Transfer of Funds and 1 2 Supplementary Appropriations 3 FOR the purpose of transferring an appropriation of funds from the Contingency Account 4 of the Chief Administrative Officer to the Department of Public Works and the 5 Department of Social Services; making supplementary appropriations from 6 unanticipated revenues to certain special funds of the County government for the 7 current fiscal year; and making and generally relating to transfers appropriations of 8 funds in and supplementary appropriations of funds to the current expense budget for 9 10 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017. 11 12 BY amending: Current Expense Budget 13 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, the County Executive may 14 authorize transfers of funds within the same department and within the same fund; 15 and 16 17 18 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, upon recommendation of the County Executive, the County Council may transfer funds between offices, 19 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies of the County 20 government and within the same fund of the Current Expense Budget; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the County Executive, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations 24 from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget or from 25

revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates for 1 the current fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing 2 that such funds are available for appropriation; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the transfer of certain funds 5 and supplementary appropriations, and the Controller has certified in writing that 6 such funds are available for appropriation; now, therefore, 7 8 SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, 9 Maryland, That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, be 10 and it is hereby amended by transferring the appropriation of funds from the below-listed 11 department in the amount set forth: 12 13 Chief Administrative Office - General Fund Appropriation 14 15 Contingency Grants, Contributions & Other 16 \$2,251,800 \$2,015,800 17 and by transferring such appropriation of funds to the below-listed departments in the 18 19 respective amount set forth: 20 Department of Public Works - General Fund Appropriation 21 Bureau of Highways 22 23 Contractual Services \$1,194,700 24 Supplies and Materials \$ 621,100 25 Department of Social Services - General Fund Appropriation 26 27 **Adult Services** 28 Grants, Contributions & Other \$ 436,000 <u>\$200,000</u> 29 SECTION 2.
