| 11 | WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, the County Executive may |
| 12 | authorize transfers of funds within the same department and within the same fund; |

| 20 | WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the |
| 21 | County Executive, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations |
| 22 | from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget or from |
| 23 24 | revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates for |
| 25 | the current fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing |
| 26 | that such funds are available for appropriation; and |
| 27 | WHEREAS & 5 105(a) of the Education Article of the Armstated Code of |
| 28 | WHEREAS, § 5-105(a) of the Education Article of the Annotated Code of |
| 20 | Maryland, requires that all revenues received by the Board of Education be spent |

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in accordance with the major categories of its annual budget as provided under § 5-101 of the Education Article, and § 5-105(b) of the Education Article requires that transfers between major categories be approved by the County Council; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended transfer of appropriation of certain funds, and the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for transfer; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, be and it is hereby amended by transferring the appropriation of funds from the below-listed department in the amount set forth:

Chief Administrative Office – General Fund Appropriation Contingency

Grants, Contributions & Other

\$ 3,085,000

and by transferring such appropriation of funds to the below-listed department in the amount set forth:

Board of Education – General Fund Appropriation County Contribution

\$ 3,085,000

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, is hereby amended by making supplementary appropriations of such funds enumerated in Section 1 of this Ordinance to the below-listed accounts in the Local Education Fund in the respective amounts set forth:
