A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Payment in Lieu of Taxes - Annapolis Solar Park 2 3 FOR the purpose of approving exemptions from County property taxes for certain property 4 located in the City of Annapolis in Anne Arundel County; authorizing the County Executive to enter into a certain agreement for payment of a negotiated amount in lieu 5 of County property taxes; and providing for the time and terms under which the 6 payment in lieu of taxes and tax exemptions will take effect. 7 8 9 WHEREAS, Annapolis Solar Park, LLC leases certain property from the City of Annapolis, at the City-owned and closed Annapolis Landfill property, located in 10 the vicinity of Interstate 97, Maryland Route 450, and Crownsville Road, in Anne 11 Arundel County, Maryland, and more fully described in the Land Lease Agreement 12 dated August 12, 2015 between the City of Annapolis and Annapolis Solar Park, 13 LLC, said Lease being an exhibit to the proposed Agreement between Anne 14 Arundel County and Annapolis Solar Park, LLC that is the subject of this Ordinance 15 16 and is incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth, for the purposes of 17 design, construction, and operation of a solar photovoltaic generating facility (the "Annapolis Solar Park"); and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, Anne Arundel County has entered into solar energy power purchase agreements with Annapolis Solar Park, LLC to purchase power generated by the 21 22 Annapolis Solar Park as approved by Bill No. 9-17; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes there is a public benefit to a solar power-producing facility located in the County on property owned by the City of 25

Annapolis that provides electricity to the County through power purchase agreements; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 6-102(e) of the Tax-Property Article of the State Code, property owned by a governmental entity and leased to a third party in connection with a business that is conducted for profit is subject to County real property tax; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 7-501 of the Tax-Property Article of the State Code, the County may exempt property owned by a governmental entity and leased to a third party in connection with a business that is conducted for profit from County property tax and may negotiate a payment in lieu of tax; and

WHEREAS, § 7-237(b) of the Tax-Property Article provides that 50% of the value of machinery or equipment used to generate electricity for sale is subject to County property tax; and

WHEREAS, § 7-514 of the Tax-Property Article provides that the County may enter into an agreement with the owner of a facility for the generation of electricity located in the County for a negotiated payment by the owner in lieu of taxes on the facility; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has negotiated a payment in lieu of County property tax for the Annapolis Solar Park, including the machinery and equipment that is part of the Annapolis Solar Park and is subject to taxation under § 7-237 of the Tax-Property Article, as set forth in the proposed Agreement between the County and Annapolis Solar Park, LLC, incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth (the "PILOT Agreement"); now, therefore,

 SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That, in accordance with the Tax-Property Article, § 7-501, of the State Code, there is an exemption from County property taxes for the Annapolis Solar Park, located at the Cityowned and closed Annapolis Landfill property, in the vicinity of Interstate 97, Maryland Route 450, and Crownsville Road, Anne Arundel County, Maryland, and more fully described in the Land Lease Agreement dated August 12, 2015 between the City of Annapolis and Annapolis Solar Park, LLC, said Lease being an exhibit to the PILOT Agreement, incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth, being portions of Tax Account Numbers 200004353300, 200090035291, and 200090045737 (the "Property"), and the machinery and equipment that is part of the Annapolis Solar Park and is subject to taxation under § 7-237 of the Tax-Property Article.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into the PILOT Agreement with Annapolis Solar Park, LLC, incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth, as the lessee of the Property, for a payment in lieu of property taxes for the Property and for the machinery and equipment that is part of the Annapolis Solar Park and is subject to taxation under § 7-237 of the Tax-Property Article.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That copies of the executed PILOT Agreement between Anne Arundel County and Annapolis Solar Park, LLC, shall be kept permanently on file with the Administrative Officer to the County Council.

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SECTION 4. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
