20	Rule 1-103. Meetings.

EXPLANATION:

(d) **Participation in decision.** Only those members who have actually heard all the evidence and testimony in an appeal shall participate in the decision unless all parties to the appeal shall agree otherwise, except that, IF THE MINIMUM ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS ARE MET, the Chair of the hearing shall have the ability to permit a member to listen to the official stenographer's recording for any missed hearing or any missed portion of a hearing, as applicable, and participate in the decision. [In no event shall a member be permitted to participate in a decision if that member misses the first hearing on any appeal.] A MEMBER MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN A DECISION IF THEY DO NOT ATTEND THE SOLE HEARING ON AN APPEAL. IF MORE THAN ONE HEARING IS SCHEDULED FOR AN APPEAL WITH MORE THAN ONE HEARING DATE, A MEMBER SHALL ATTEND AT LEAST ONE OF THE FIRST TWO HEARINGS OF ANY APPEAL IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE DECISION.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That a certified copy of the Rules of Practice and Procedure approved by this Ordinance shall be kept permanently on file in the Office of the Administrative Officer to the County Council and in the Office of the County Board of Appeals.
