A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning: Indian Hills Special Community Benefit District -1 2 Approval of Loan and Loan Modification Agreement 3 FOR the purpose of obligating the County to levy the special tax known as the special 4 community benefit assessment on the Indian Hills Special Community Benefit 5 District in an amount sufficient to repay a loan from First-Citizens Bank & Trust 6 Company to the Indian Hills Community Association, Inc., in each of eleven (11) 7 fiscal years during the term of the loan. 8 9 10 WHEREAS, the Indian Hills Special Community Benefit District has been duly formed and created, pursuant to procedures set forth in Anne Arundel County 11 Code, Article 4, Title 7; and 12 13 WHEREAS, pursuant to § 4-7-204(jj)(2) of the Anne Arundel County Code, the 14 purposes of the Indian Hills Special Community Benefit District include "the 15 construction, operation, maintenance, and repair of certain community-owned 16 property and improvements within the boundaries of the district, including 17 18 resurfacing and sealing of the existing tennis courts; installation of drainage pipe and drainage systems; installation of a basketball court; renovation of the log 19 20 cabin by removing partitions, paneling walls, installing new windows, repairing ceilings, repairing and carpeting floor, correcting water problem in the basement. 21 22 installing a new septic system, installing, replacing, and repairing recreation equipment as necessary; and renovation and reconstruction of the community pool 23 and its related facilities, including all related equipment, and the payment of the 24 25 pool's yearly operational and maintenance expenses"; and

WHEREAS, the Indian Hills Community Association, Inc. (the "Association") is the civic or community association that meets the requirements of § 4-7-101(d) that administers the District; and

WHEREAS, in November of 2014, the Association entered into a loan agreement with First-Citizens Bank & Trust Company in the amount of \$310,000 with a term of eleven (11) years for the purpose of providing funding for improvements to community property and to pay the balance on an existing loan for improvements to community property (the "Original Loan"); and

WHEREAS, the Original Loan and associated Loan Agreement were approved by the Anne Arundel County Council in Bill No. 57-15; and

WHEREAS, the Original Loan balance is approximately \$245,000; and

WHEREAS, the Association is modifying the Original Loan by increasing the principal loan amount to \$305,000, and extending the term by two years (through December 2027) through December 2027, to facilitate a tennis court replacement and fence construction project (the "Modified Loan"); and

WHEREAS, to enable the Association to obtain the Loan from First-Citizens Bank & Trust Company by providing a source of funds for repayment of the Modified Loan, the County is undertaking the obligation set forth in this Ordinance; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the County shall be obligated to levy the special tax known as the special community benefit assessment on the Indian Hills Special Community Benefit District in an amount sufficient to repay the Modified Loan from First-Citizens Bank & Trust Company to Indian Hills Community Association, Inc., in each of up to eleven (11) fiscal years during the term of the Modified Loan, beginning in the County's Fiscal Year 2018.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the County undertakes no obligation with regard to the Modified Loan except as expressly described in this Ordinance, is neither a co-obligor nor guarantor of the Modified Loan, and does not commit the full faith and credit of the County to repayment of the Modified Loan.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That the County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into such other and further agreements with the Association and First-Citizens Bank & Trust Company as are necessary to disburse directly to First-Citizens Bank & Trust Company such amounts of the special community benefit assessment levied on the Indian Hills Special Community Benefit District as are collected by the County and are necessary to repay the Modified Loan consistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
