A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Subdivision and Development – Adequate Public School  
2 Facilities – School Utilization Chart

3  
4 FOR the purpose of approving the 2019 School Utilization Chart prepared by the  
5 Planning and Zoning Officer.

7 WHEREAS, Section 17-5-502(a) of the Anne Arundel County Code provides that  
8 the Planning and Zoning Officer shall prepare a school utilization chart no later  
9 than November 30 each year for the approval by ordinance of the County  
10 Council; and

12 WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Officer has prepared a new school  
13 utilization chart based on information supplied by the Board of Education and the  
14 requirements of § 17-5-502 of the Anne Arundel County Code; now therefore

16 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*  
17 *Maryland,* That the ‘School Utilization Chart by Feeder System Based on 2019 Projected  
18 Enrollment’, attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A, is hereby approved and shall take  
19 effect on the date this Ordinance takes effect.

21 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days  
22 from the date it becomes law.
