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### A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Finance, Taxation, and Budget – Real Property Taxes –  
2 Clean Energy Loan Program

3  
4 FOR the purpose of removing a certain requirement for the Clean Energy Loan Program;  
5 changing certain eligibility requirements for a Clean Energy Loan; and generally  
6 relating to finance, taxation, and budget.

7  
8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 4-2-401(b) and (f)(2)  
9 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

11 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
12 That Sections of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

#### 13 14 **ARTICLE 4. FINANCE, TAXATION, AND BUDGET**

#### 15 16 **TITLE 2. REAL PROPERTY TAXES**

#### 17 18 **4-2-401. Clean Energy Loan Program.**

20 (b) **Program.** There is a Clean Energy Loan Program to finance energy efficiency  
21 projects and renewable energy projects [[with an electric generating capacity of not more  
22 than 100 kilowatts]], as provided in the Local Government Article, §§1-1101 et seq., of the  
23 State Code.



6 the [[energy]] savings projected to be obtained from the improvements over the life of the  
7 Clean Energy Loan equal or exceed the principal and aggregate interest to be paid over the  
8 term of the loan;

12 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days  
13 from the date it becomes law.


