1 RESOLUTION endorsing financial assistance from the Maryland Economic  
2 Development Assistance Authority and Fund to Vision Technologies, Inc.

4 WHEREAS, Vision Technologies, Inc., a national and global system integrator,  
5 has applied for a loan by the Maryland Department of Commerce from the  
6 Maryland Economic Development Assistance Authority and Fund (“MEDAAF”)  
7 in the amount of \$600,000 (the “Financial Assistance”); and

9 WHEREAS, the Financial Assistance will be used by Vision Technologies, Inc.  
10 to relocate its headquarters to newly renovated space in the County (the  
11 “project”); and

13 WHEREAS, in accordance with § 5-319(d)(1) of the Economic Development  
14 Article of the State Code, the governing body of the jurisdiction in which a project  
15 is located must endorse the financial assistance to be provided from MEDAAF by  
16 formal resolution; and



18 WHEREAS, the County Executive endorses the financial assistance; now,  
19 therefore, be it

21 *Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,* That it endorses  
22 the loan by the Maryland Department of Commerce from the Maryland Economic  
23 Development Assistance Authority and Fund in the amount of \$600,000 to Vision  
24 Technologies, Inc. to be used to relocate its headquarters to newly renovated space in the  
25 County; and be it further
