SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

The purpose of this legislation is to make supplementary appropriations from unanticipated grant revenue, and provide additional funding for a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) cost recovery consultant in the Office of Emergency Management and a project in the Capital Budget.

Exhibit 1 summarizes the appropriation of \$2,249,419 of revenue in the Grants Special Revenue Fund and \$17,313,628 of revenue in the Community Development Fund received from sources not anticipated in the budget. Although the Office of Transportation grant requires a 20% county match, this can be absorbed within the existing appropriation for the Office. No other grants require a county match.
