FISCAL NOTE

BILL: AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE CONCERNING: CURRENT EXPENSE BUDGET – BOARD OF EDUCATION -- SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION AND TRANSFER OF FUNDS

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

This bill appropriates \$9,365,700 of additional funds to the Board of Education (BOE) and transfers funds among major categories of expenditure in the Local Education Fund.

FISCAL IMPACT

Section 1 of the bill recognizes \$9,365,700 of combined State and Federal grants, and local revenues. Section 2 of the bill decreases appropriations by a total of \$21,679,700. Funds from the grants, local revenues, and decreased appropriations are the sources to provide increased appropriations of \$31,045,400 reflected in Section 3 of the bill. The table below shows that sources and appropriation decreases and increases:
