A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget - Transfer of Funds and 1 Supplementary Appropriations 2 3 FOR the purpose of transferring appropriations of funds between certain offices, 4 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies in the general fund; 5 making supplementary appropriations from unanticipated revenues to certain funds in 6 the budget for the current fiscal year; and generally relating to transferring 7 appropriations of funds and supplementary appropriations to the current expense 8 9 budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019. 10 BY amending: Current Expense Budget 11 12 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, the County Executive may 13 authorize transfers of funds within the same department and within the same fund; 14 and 15 16 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, upon recommendation of the 17 County Executive, the County Council may transfer funds between offices, 18 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies of the County 19 government and within the same fund of the Current Expense Budget; and 20 21 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the 22 County Executive, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations 23 from revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates 24

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and from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget for the

current fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such funds are available for appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the transfer and supplementary appropriation of certain funds, and the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for appropriation; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, be and it is hereby amended by transferring the appropriation of funds from the below-listed department in the amount set forth:

Chief Administrative Office – General Fund Appropriation Office of Personnel

15 Grants, Contributions & Other

\$ 468,300

and by transferring such appropriation of funds to the below-listed department in the amount set forth:

Office of Personnel – General Fund Appropriation
Office of Personnel
Contractual Services

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, be and it is hereby amended by making supplementary appropriations from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget or from revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates as follows in the total amount of \$185,400 \$873,200 to the Grants Special Revenue Fund, and as follows:
