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A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Transfer of Funds and  
2 Supplementary Appropriations  
3  
4 FOR the purpose of transferring an appropriation of funds from the Contingency Account  
5 of the Chief Administrative Officer to the Office of Central Services and the Office of  
6 the State’s Attorney; making supplementary appropriations from unanticipated  
7 revenues to certain offices, departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other  
8 agencies in the general fund and to certain special funds of the County government  
9 for the current fiscal year; and making and generally relating to transfers  
10 appropriations of funds in and supplementary appropriations of funds to the current  
11 expense budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017.  
12  
13 BY amending: Current Expense Budget  
14  
15 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, the County Executive may  
16 authorize transfers of funds within the same department and within the same fund;  
17 and  
18  
19 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, upon recommendation of the  
20 County Executive, the County Council may transfer funds between offices,  
21 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies of the County  
22 government and within the same fund of the Current Expense Budget; and  
23  
24 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the  
25 County Executive, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations  
26 from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget or from  
27 revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates for

1 the current fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing  
2 that such funds are available for appropriation; and

4 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the transfer of certain funds  
5 and supplementary appropriations, and the Controller has certified in writing that  
6 such funds are available for appropriation; now, therefore,

7  
8 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*  
9 *Maryland,* That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, be  
10 and it is hereby amended by transferring the appropriation of funds from the below-listed  
11 department in the amount set forth:

13 Chief Administrative Office – General Fund Appropriation  
14 Contingency  
15 Grants, Contributions & Other \$ 599,200

17 and by transferring such appropriation of funds to the below-listed departments in the  
18 respective amount set forth:

20 Office of Central Services – General Fund Appropriation  
21 Facilities Management  
22 Contractual Services \$ 163,200  
23 Capital Outlay \$ 250,000

25 Office of the State’s Attorney – General Fund Appropriation  
26 Office of the State’s Attorney  
27 Personal Services \$ 186,000



29 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the Current Expense Budget for the  
30 fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, be and it is hereby amended by making supplementary  
31 appropriations from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget or  
32 revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates in the total  
33 amount of \$135,300 to the Grants Special Revenue Fund, as follows:
