RESOLUTION approving the application of Maxwell H. Covington, Jr., Maxwell H. 1 2 Covington, III, and Allen P. Covington, to sell an agricultural land preservation easement 3 to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation on approximately 118 acres 4 known and designated as 3169 3171 Davidsonville Road, Davidsonville, Maryland 5 6 WHEREAS, Maxwell H. Covington, Jr., Maxwell H. Covington, III, and Allen P. 7 Covington have made application (the "Covington Application") to the Maryland 8 Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation (the "Foundation") to sell an 9 agricultural land preservation easement on real property, more particularly 10 described as "Parcel No. 2" in deeds recorded among the land records of Anne Arundel County in Book 5883, Page 36; Book 5883, Page 39; and Book 14193, 11 Page 8, consisting of 118 acres, more or less, located in Anne Arundel County, 12 known and designated as 3169 3171 Davidsonville Road, Davidsonville, Maryland, 13 and shown generally on Exhibit 1, attached to this Resolution and made a part 14 15 hereof (the "Covington Property"); and 16 17 WHEREAS, pursuant to Title 2, Subtitle 5 of the Agriculture Article of the State 18 Code and regulations adopted pursuant thereto, the County governing body is required to advise the Foundation as to a local recommendation of approval or 19 disapproval of the Covington Application; and 20 21 22 WHEREAS, in deciding whether to approve the Covington Application, the County governing body is to receive the recommendation of the Office of Planning and 23 24 Zoning and the County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board (the "Board") based on criteria and standards identified in Title 2, Subtitle 5 of the Agriculture 25 Article of the State Code and regulations adopted pursuant thereto; and 26 27 28 WHEREAS, the Office of Planning and Zoning, the Board, and the County 29 Executive have recommended approval of the Covington Application; and 30 WHEREAS, the County Council finds that approval of the Covington Application 31 32 is in the best interest of the citizens of Anne Arundel County; now, therefore, be it 33 34 Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That it hereby approves the recommendation of approval of the Covington Application to sell an
