Subject: Bill No. 16-21: Personnel – Positions in the Exempt Service – Police Department

### Legislative Summary

This summary was prepared by the Anne Arundel County Office of Law for use by members of the Anne Arundel County Council during consideration of Bill No. 16-21, which modifies position control for the Police Department.

**Background.** Section 6-2-103(a) of the County Code lists certain positions in the exempt service and provides that “the number and classification of positions under each [position] title . . . shall be approved as part of the annual budget and appropriation ordinance and may not be changed during a fiscal year as part of the annual budget and appropriation ordinance and may not be changed during a fiscal year except as approved by ordinance of the County Council.” Police Majors and Police Chief of Staff are on the list of positions in the exempt service.

**Purpose.** The purpose of this Bill is to modify the personnel summary for the Police Department approved in the FY21 budget.

**Summary. Section 1** increases one Police Major (Exempt) position and one Police Chief of Staff in the Police Department.

**Section 2** of the Bill provides that it will take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
