Subject: Bill No. 2-21

Bill No. 2-21 adds bird sanctuaries as a conditional use in the RA and RLD zoning districts.

The Bill defines the use as a facility where birds are kept and given care. See 18-1-101(20).

There are five conditions for the use:

- (1) The bird sanctuary must be located on a lot of at least three acres.
- (2) Buildings and enclosures used in connection with the use must be located at least 100 feet from residentially zoned property and birds may not be kept within the 100-foot setback.
- (3) At least one person involved in the bird sanctuary must occupy any dwelling on the property.
- (4) The bird sanctuary must be operated by a tax-exempt entity and it may not be operated for commercial purposes.
- (5) The entity which operates the bird sanctuary must be accredited by the American Sanctuary Association or by the Global Federation of Animal Sanctuaries.
