Subject:	Bill No. 49-20: Personnel – Court and State's Attorney Employees' Pay and Benefit Plan	

Legislative Summary

This summary was prepared by the Anne Arundel County Office of Law for use by members of the Anne Arundel County Council during consideration of Bill No. 49-20, which modifies compensation for certain positions in the Court and State's Attorney employees' pay and benefit plan.

Purpose. The purpose of this bill is to modify the pay grades for the exempt positions of Assistant Director of Assignment and Deputy Jury Commissioner.

Background. The Court and State's Attorney employees' pay and benefit plan is set forth in § 6-2-104 of the County Code. Each exempt position in the plan is listed and assigned a pay grade. All pay grades are on the NR scale, which is set forth in § 6-1-202(a).

Summary. Section 1 of the bill modifies §§ 6-2-10-4(b)(1) to change the pay grade for the Assistant Director of Assignment and the Deputy Jury Commissioner from NR 14 to NR15.

Section 2 of the bill states that the provisions of the bill shall apply to the first pay period beginning on or after July 1, 2020.

Section 3 of the bill provides that it will take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
