Subject: Resolution No. 44-19 – “Move Anne Arundel!”, Anne Arundel County’s Transportation Functional Master Plan

Legislative Summary

This summary was prepared by the Anne Arundel County Office of Law for use by members of the Anne Arundel County Council during consideration of Resolution No. 44-19, a Resolution that seeks approval of the County’s Transportation Functional Master Plan.

Purpose.

The purpose of the Resolution is seeking approval of “Move Anne Arundel!”, the County’s proposed Transportation Functional Master Plan.

Background.

The Transportation Plan contained in Chapter 9 of the Anne Arundel County 2009 General Development Plan (“2009 GDP”) provides for the preparation of a Transportation Functional Master Plan, and requires the Plan to address a list of topics relating to transportation management. A copy of the list of transportation elements required under the 2009 GDP is attached. Bill No. 78-18, which adopted certain County Code provisions relating to multi-modal transportation, required the Transportation Functional Master Plan to be prepared by the Office of Transportation no later than November 23, 2019.

“Move Anne Arundel!” is the Transportation Functional Master Plan prepared by the Office of Transportation, in accordance with the Transportation Plan in the 2009 GDP and Bill No. 78-18. Section 18-2-103 of the County Code provides for the adoption of master plans by the County Council as a guide to future development of land and the location of public services and facilities by the County.
