Subject: Bill No. 32-22

Bill No. 32-22 provides that the tax on admissions and amusement charges may not be imposed in August of 2022 or August of 2023 if, within 15 days after the date of written notice, the taxpayer declares under the penalties of perjury that the monetary benefit of not having to pay the tax in these months will be passed along to the consumer.

This Ordinance remain in effect through August 31, 2023, after which it is automatically repealed.
