1	AN ORDINANCE concerning: Subdivision and Development – Modifications

3	FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain types of modifications in cluster subdivisions; and
4	generally relating to subdivision and development.

6	BY renumbering: § 17-2-108(d) and (e) to be § 17-2-108(e) and (g), respectively
7	Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

9	BY adding: § 17-2-108(d) and (f)

12	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,
13	Maryland, That § 17-2-108(d) and (e) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as
14	amended) are here by renumbered to be § 17-2-108(e) and (g), respectively.

16	SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, that Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County
17	Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

23	17-2-108. Modifications.

25	(D) Modification for payment of fee-in-lieu. A MODIFICATION IS NOT REQUIRED
26	FOR THE PLANNING AND ZONING OFFICER TO APPROVE PAYMENT OF A FEE-IN-LIEU INTO

THE COUNTY'S FOREST CONSERVATION FUND, AS PROVIDED IN TITLE 6, SUBTITLE 3 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(F) **Modifications for cluster subdivisions.** THE PLANNING AND ZONING OFFICER MAY NOT GRANT A MODIFICATION TO THE FOREST CONSERVATION, RECREATION AREA, OR OPEN SPACE REQUIREMENTS FOR A CLUSTER SUBDIVISION WITH AN APPLICATION FOR SUBDIVISION FILED AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF BILL NO. 27-17.

SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That all references in this Ordinance to "the effective date of Bill No. 27-17", or words to that effect, shall, upon codification, be replaced with the actual date on which this Ordinance takes effect under Section 307 of the County Charter as certified by the Administrative Officer to the County Council.

SECTION 4. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
